Stabling

Stabling is limited, please send entry early if stabling is required. Stabling will be assigned on a “first come first serve” basis by entry receipt. Permanent 12 x 12 stalls with dutch doors. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. Smoking is prohibited in stall and barn areas. Horses must not arrive prior to 12PM the day prior to the competition without permission from show management and must be off grounds 1 hour after the last ride unless permission has been granted by show management.

Bedding: If required bedding must be purchased on entry form. Competitors may bring their own shavings and/or sawdust.

Dress - Informal riding attire, must wear riding boots with a heel and helmet. Horse must be properly represented by USDF/USEF rules with no schooling equipment when shown.

Classes/Awards: Classes with less than 6 entries within a level may be combined and pinned on a % basis. Classes may run in a different numerical order. Organizer reserve the right to add combine or otherwise change classes as the need arises. Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place for each class.

Directions: From Louisville: I-64 E to I-71 to I-265 S, Exit 30, turn right off ramp onto LaGrange Rd, turn right onto Reamers Rd, turn right on Adrienne Way, first drive on right. From Lexington: I-64 W to I-265 N, Exit 19B, then take exit 30. turn right off ramp onto LaGrange Rd, turn right onto Reamers Rd, turn right on Adrienne Way, first drive on right. No Show: All “no shows” that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

Ride Times: All email addresses must be clearly printed. Ride times and show updates will be posted at www.stonehurstridingclub.com. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform show management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving their ride times.

Entry Cancellation/Refunds/Hazardous Weather/Acts of God/Emergencies: Cancellations only in writing either by mail or email prior to or on the closing date. No refunds for any reason after closing date unless you can find someone to take all your exact rides and ride times, then if so, entire entry fees minus office fee will be refunded. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

Other: All dogs must be leashed and attached to a person or immovable object. All entries must include a negative Coggins report dated within one year of the show date. Entries must be legible and include all signatures, in addition to full payment. Trailers larger than standard six-horse trailers will need to enter from side entrance. Please call facility in advance to open gates (502) 550-2230.

Arenas: Indoor 20m x x60m sand competition arena with 1 large outdoor sand warm-up arena and one lungeing pen. All tests are in standard arena-in case of overfill; show may elect to run classes in a short arena.
